Bullock Selected as Interim Superintendent



At a special called meeting on November 30, the School Board unanimously approved **Robin Bullock** as the MISD interim superintendent contingent upon successful contract negotiations between Dr. Kennedy and McKinney ISD. Dr. Kennedy is currently the lone finalist for the position of McKinney ISD Superintendent of Schools. A contract can't be awarded before December 16, 2009. He will assume his new position on January 1, 2010.

Bullock will work in collaboration with the School Board, administrative staff, parents and community leaders, while also maintaining stability and accountability until a new superintendent is hired.

The School Board is in the process of hiring a superintendent search firm to assist in hiring a new superintendent.

Bullock received her Masters of Science in Secondary Education from Troy State University in Alabama, earned Educational Administration certification and Superintendent certification through The University of Texas at Arlington, and received a Bachelor of Arts in Secondary English Education from Northwestern State University in Louisiana.
