Resolution in Opposition to the Use of Public Funds to Private and Non-profit Organizations for Direct Student Services

WHEREAS, the Texas Education Agency, serves as an administrative arm of the State of Texas to carry out public education purposes

WHEREAS, the Texas Education Agency has no authority to grant public money to nonprofit organizations to provide direct student services

WHEREAS, the legislature has never authorized the spending of taxpayer dollars on private schools


WHEREAS, public schools need all resources possible from the State of Texas to provide dropout prevention services to its students in need of such services and the diverting of public monies to a private school reduces the money available to public schools
