

# Student Council Representative Permission Form Due by September 3

Student Council members will plan, organize and implement service projects throughout the school year. This includes Cat Night, Teacher Appreciation Dinner, WGMS Spring Reunion Ice Cream Social, Once A Cat Always A Cat Scholarship, Red Ribbon Week, campus paper recycling, etc.

Student Council requires a commitment of time outside of the normal school day and willingness to represent your fellow Wildcats.
